

Bingo at Cedarbrook April 10 - Volunteers and Prizes Needed



This week please meet Lynn Terry who has two roles at Light of Christ, as Christian Education Director and Director of the MLCCC school. She tells us about these important education roles:



The major role of the Christian Education Director and the role of the director of the MLCCC is to share the love of God with all of the children and families who enter our doors.

As the Christian Education Director, I oversee the Sunday School program, the confirmation program, the Bible program, First Holy Communion classes, special programs of the Sunday School including Rally Day, the Children's Christmas Eve Service, the Lenten Fair, the closing of Sunday School, and Vacation Bible School. Within each of these areas there are many responsibilities and many people who work with me to proclaim the love of God to children and their

families. Since August of 2017 I have been working with Pastor Jerry to extend children's ministry to include the children of the UPG.

As the MLCCC Director I oversee the daily operations of our preschool program, which includes but is not limited to leading staff meetings, submitting payroll, billing, ordering, teacher training, special programs, working with the school board and this year teaching our three-year old class. I have brought a chapel program to the preschool which includes teaching Bible stories, songs and prayers twice a month to all classes. Three times a year families and friends are invited to a special chapel program held in our sanctuary.

Through all of this work God's Love and Word is my guide. It is my goal for all of God's children to know and experience His love through the children's ministry of our church.




RECENTLY IN THE UPG

Did you know?...

There is a blanket-making ministry at St. Peter's that literally helps people around the world!

Here is their story, with information provided by Elizabeth Elterich.

In 2015-2016, the St. Peter's blanket makers' group made about 12 quilts. Richard Elterich registered the quilts on the Lutheran World Relief (LWR) website to let them know the congregation of origin. The quilts would first go to the Church World Service Center (CWSC) in New Windsor, MD, an official distributor for LWR.

Elizabeth Elterich contacted Pr. Rebecca Knox from Reading, who was taking blankets from her own congregation to CWSC. Elizabeth gave the St. Peter's quilts to Pr. Knox and they were on their way.

Fast forward to November 2017. Elizabeth got an email from LWR saying the blankets had been distributed in India to persons whose lives have been affected by AIDS. They sent a picture (at right) of a young lady with a St. Peter's blanket folded on her lap. Not long after, *Photo used with permission of* a LWR printed brochure was distributed - the copy received at St. Peter's featured the same picture of the young lady from India.

Some more St. Peter's blankets were also featured in that brochure.

The blanket makers' work continued and in September 2017, another 12 blankets from St. Peter's were given to the CWSC for distribution all around the world.
