The last few weeks, we have been hearing a message resounding from the halls of the 2018 Youth Gathering in Houston! "God's Call changes everything!, God's Love changes everything! God's Grace changes everything!" Next week we will hear how "God's Hope changes everything!" That sure is a great deal of everything being changed!

The UPG has experienced a great deal of change since her inception! Many of our ministries of been "melded" together. Ministry teams have been formed and are up and running, and each step taken during the summer months has been guided by the congregational questionnaires that the people of the UPG completed immediately following the Easter season. Compiled results from the questionnaires, along with comments, are available in the narthex as you leave the worship space and will be distributed following worship on August 19.

I wanted to take this opportunity to share with you a few happenings that are just around the corner. On Sunday August 19, we will be holding a brief "Town Hall Meeting" immediately following our outdoor worship. During this meeting we will be offering each person in attendance a "snapshot" picture of the many wonderful ministries occurring within the UPG along with current financial information to assess the financial implications of the UPG.

During our UPG leadership retreat in July, the congregational council endorsed taking a "congregational poll" to see if there is interest in extending the UPG arrangement, which currently concludes in September of 2019, and extending this arrangement for an additional three years (September 2022). The logic for this request is that this will give us more time to discern where God is leading us as a people, while at the same time allowing for more shared expenses in our mission to proclaim the "Good News" of God's love for the world.

My hope is that this "congregational poll" will take place at a UPG Forum following our joint worship celebration on September 9, 2018 on our St. Peter's Campus. This "congregational poll" will then be acted on by our congregational church councils at our regularly scheduled September meeting.

My hopes and prayers are that each one of you has been able to experience, see, and feel the Holy Spirit working within our midst during this past year! May our Lord continue to lead and guide the direction of the United Proclamation of the Gospel in Bethlehem. Peace, PJ
