## **May Council Meeting Highlights**

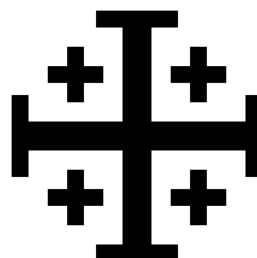
